Keesha's House Sonnet Worksheet

A sonnet is a 14-line poem, usually rhyming. There are lots of different kinds of sonnets. Using the sonnets in <i>Keesha's House</i> as examples, plan your rhyme scheme, putting the letters a, b, c, etc. at the ends of the lines to remind you which lines should rhyme with which others. (The letters stand for rhymes at the ends of the lines. An "a" at the end of a line means the line rhymes with another "a" word, a "b" rhymes with another "b" word, etc.) Remember, rhymes don't have to be exact, and sonnets don't have to be divided into stanzas.
